This is built around a gateway process at key milestones, which records KPIs, lessons learnt and mutual targets moving forward. These are shared with the wider framework and clients to ensure key lessons are learnt and performance remains positive.

The Contractors KPIs are used to ensure they are delivering to the highest standards, failure to do so will result in suspension from bidding opportunities on the framework.

In addition to KPIs and lessons learnt, contractors are also required to undertake an employment and skills plan on every project, aligned to the CITB industry standards.
